

Watercolor Class Supply List

This is my suggested list of supplies for the class.

Paper

Arches, Fabriano Artistico or Fluid 140lb cold pressed in either sheet or block form. 10"X14" size block, quarter sheet 11"X15" cut from 22"X30" full sheet.

You will need a board larger by 2" all around to accommodate the paper, and clips or tape to secure it. I recommend ½" Frog tape [green].

Paint

Winsor&Newton, not Cotman, Holbein, M. Graham, Daniel Smith are suggested.

Cadmium yellow

Cadmium orange

Cadmium red

Alizarin Crimson, permanent

Cerulean Blue or Verditer blue

Sap green or Olive green

Cobalt blue

Ultramarine blue or French Ultramarine blue

Burnt umber

Burnt sienna or Quinacridone gold

Additional colors:

Aureolin yellow, Lemon yellow

Cobalt violet

Indigo

Viridian

Leaf green

Palette

Plastic folding palette or palette with at least 12 wells and ample mixing area. Most of these come with covers that keep colors from drying out.

Brushes

#4, #8, #12 and 1" flat. Sable brushes are best but Simply Simons will work.

Additional supplies

At least pint size plastic container for water

#2 or hb pencil, this can be mechanical or wooden

Spray bottle

Paper towels, Viva is most absorbent

Dollar store tissues [no oils]

Kneaded eraser

Pencil sharpener

Utility or Xacto knife

Frog tape

Natural sponge or Kitchen sponge
